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## INTRODUCTION:

This International Merchandise Trade (IMTS) statistics provides information on Tuvalu's exports, re-exports and imports of goods between Tuvalu, and the rest of the world. The administrative data used to compile this release is supplied by the Tuvalu Customs department through the online ASYCUDA system.

The IMTS release reports traded goods in correspondence to the Harmonised Coding System of Tuvalu (HS) which are classified into categories by commodity and country.

This report aims to provide users with relevant trade data that can be applied to develop better planning and consult trade deals in order to develop progress on relevant trade policies.

As follows is the IMTS bi-annual release for the second half of 2023 which includes a monthly trend from January to December, an annual trend from 2019 to 2023, along with the nine release tables containing Tuvalu's imports, exports and re-exports to further assist users.

**ANALYSES:**

**1. Value of Imports and Exports:**

Figure 1 compares monthly values of total imports in 2023 with its values in 2022.

In contrast, the monthly values of imports in 2022 were relatively low compared to 2023, with 2022 averaging around \$4.1 million and 2023 averaging \$5.4 million. Total imports in 2023 peaked in June to approximately \$7.07 million and recoded its lowest value of \$2.58 million in December. In comparison

to 2023, the highest import value of the two years of \$7.88 million was recorded on August 2022 and the lowest of \$1.66 million was on January 2022.

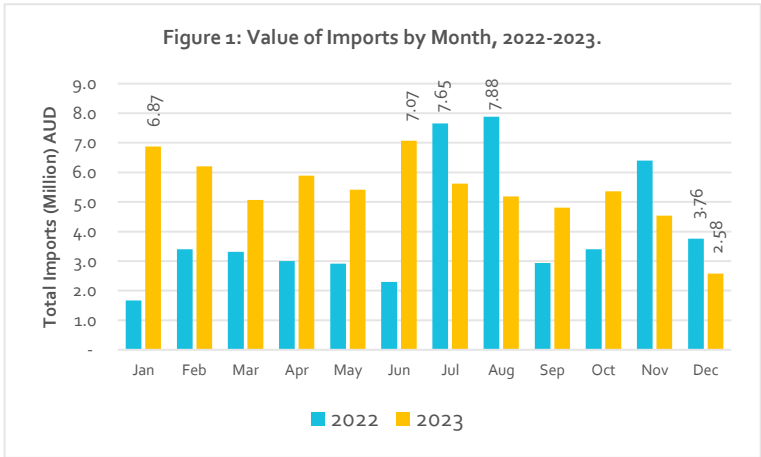
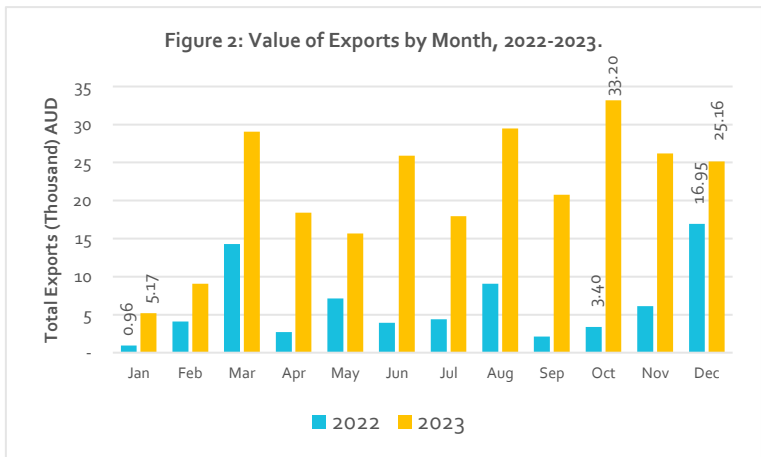


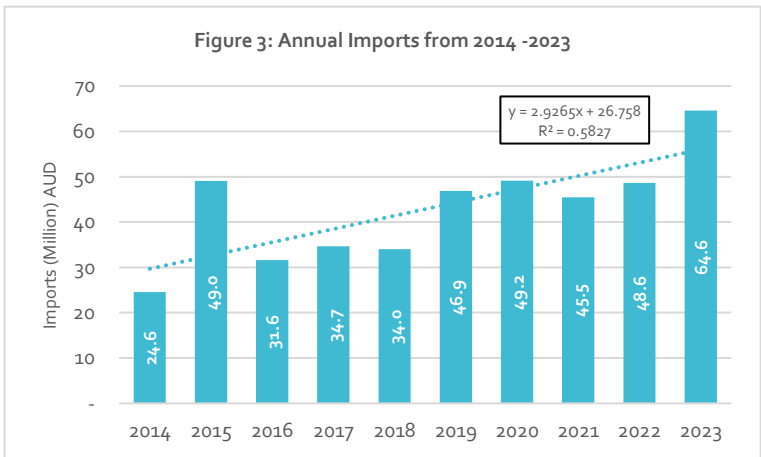
Figure 2 reveals a significant leap in total exports for all months for the year 2022 to 2023, with total exports for 2022 averaging around \$6.3 thousand and leaped by about 3.4 times to an average of about \$21.3 thousand in 2023. Figure 2 also confirms that January records the least amount of exports for both 2022 and 2023 with total exports of about \$0.96 thousand and \$5.2 thousand respectively. However, total exports peaked around December for the year 2022 with around \$17 thousand and October of 2023, with approximately \$33.2 thousand.



*\*Note: Due to the uplift of Tuvalu’s borders after COVID 19 lockdown, re-exports of Mineral Products to Airlines travelling in and out of Tuvalu played a major influence on the value of exports in 2023.*

**2014-2023:** Figure 3 illustrates the annual imports for the past decade, revealing an increasing trend that grows an average amount of about \$2.93 million each year.

As for the annual exports illustrated in Figure 4, the first 5 years between 2014 and 2018 reveals a relatively stable trend averaging around \$280 thousand.



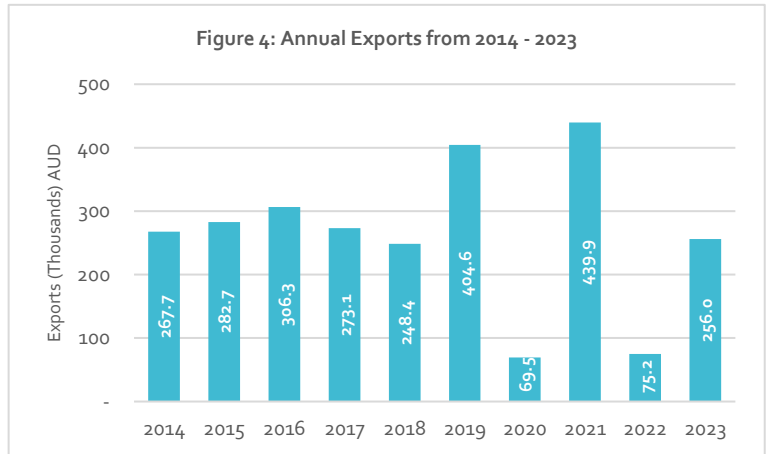
However, some major events occurred in the next 5 years that have some significant impact on the value of imports and exports as evident in Figure 4.

2019: The 50<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Pacific Island Forum (PIF’s) was held in Tuvalu from August 13-16, 2019. Therefore, total imports grew by 38% and total exports grew by 63% mainly due to the increased number of airplanes arriving.

2020: A notable drop in total exports (83%) during the Covid19 pandemic and a slight increase in total imports (5%) from 2019 to 2020.

2021: A significant spike was noticed in Figure 4 as a noticeable export of life-rafts was exported out to Fiji, valuing around \$350 thousand which is about 80% of total export for that year.



2022-2023: Tuvalu’s COVID 19 pandemic lockdown was slowly uplifted towards the end of 2022 and therefore had a notable impact on Tuvalu’s trade, with total imports growing by 33% and exports leaped 3.4 times to around \$256 thousand which is within the normal range prior the COVID and PIF’s meeting event.

## 2. Balance of Trade:

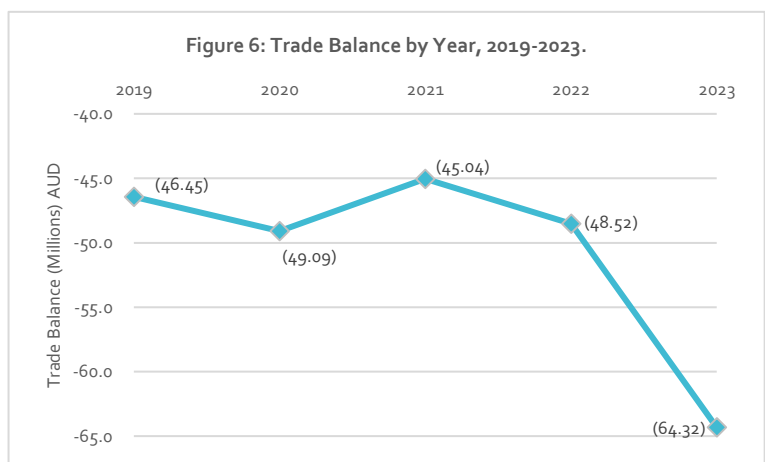
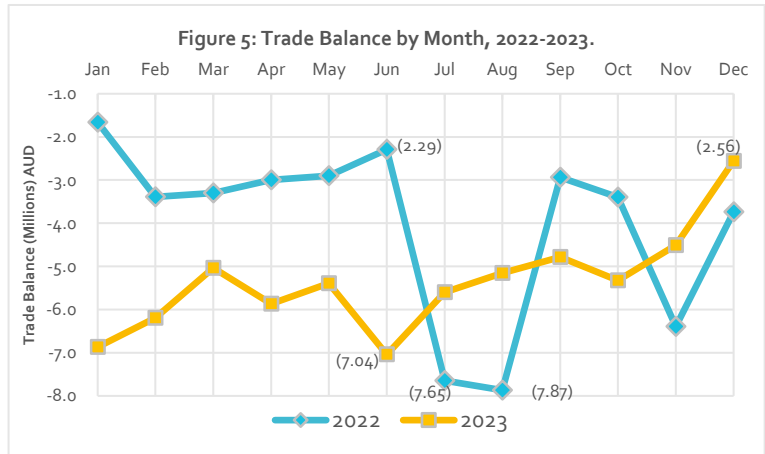
**December 2023:** The lowest monthly trade deficit for 2023 was marked in December 2023 as -\$2.6 million whereas the greatest monthly trade deficit was in June as -\$7.0 million.

The trade deficit in June 2022 had significantly increased by 3.3 times to an estimated \$7.7 million deficit which also increased slightly by 3% the following month to \$7.9 million.

**2019-2023:** Figure 6 alongside demonstrates Tuvalu’s trade balance throughout the five consecutive years, and it shows;

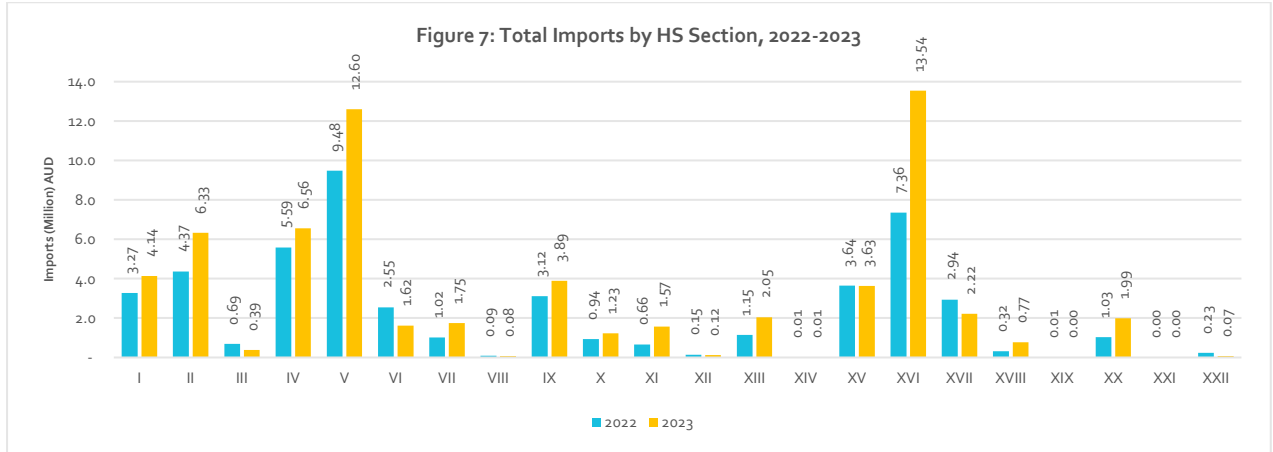
Trade balance in the 4-year period between 2019 to 2023 fluctuated around an average of -\$47.3 million, then it dropped sharply to an outstanding deficit of \$64.3 million, a 33% fall from 2022 deficit, due to a dominant increase in imports as the economy recovers from COVID lockdown.

The lowest deficit recorded was in 2021 with an estimated \$45.0 million, which was helped by the spike in exports from life rafts.



### 3. Performance of Imports:

#### i. Total annual imports movement

Figure 7 above compares the annual movement of imports by their HS Sections for the 2 years, 2022 and 2023.

The top 3 commodities with the highest increase (positive changes) in total imports for 2023 when compared to 2022 were;

- 1 • **MACHINERY & MECHANICAL & ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES & PARTS (XVI)**  
 • Increased by \$6.18 million to a total of \$13.54 million in 2023, compared to the total imports of 2022.
- 2 • **MINERAL PRODUCTS (V)**  
 • Increased by \$3.12 million to a total of \$12.6 million in 2023, compared to the total imports of 2022.
- 3 • **VEGETABLE PRODUCTS (II)**  
 • Increased by \$1.96 million to a total of \$6.33 million in 2023, compared to the total imports of 2022.

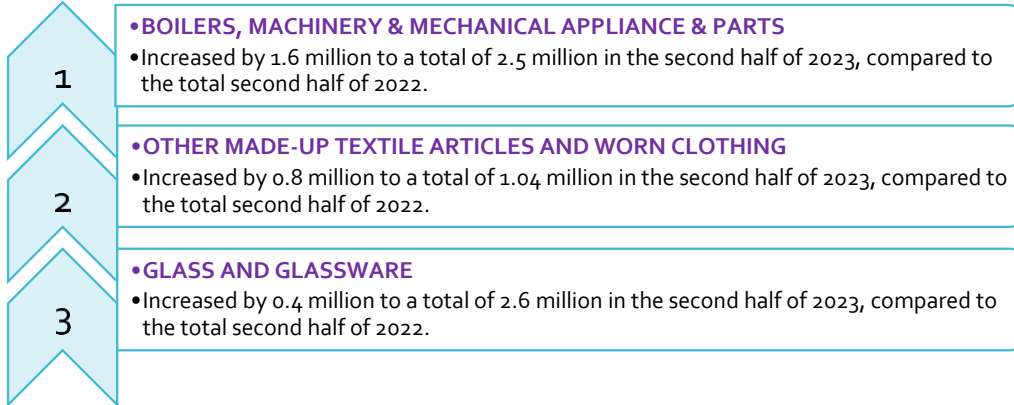
The top 3 commodities with the highest drop (negative changes) in total imports for 2023 when compared to 2022 were;

- 1 • **CHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS (VI)**  
 • Decreased by \$0.93 million to a total of \$1.62 million in 2023, compared to the total imports of 2022.
- 2 • **VEHICLES, AIRCRAFT & ASSOCIATED TRANSPORT EQUIPMENT (XVII)**  
 • Decreased by \$0.72 million to a total of \$2.22 million in 2023, compared to the total imports of 2022.
- 3 • **ANIMAL OR VEGETABLE OILS & FATS (III)**  
 • Decreased by \$0.3 million to a total of \$0.39 million in 2023, compared to the total imports of 2022.

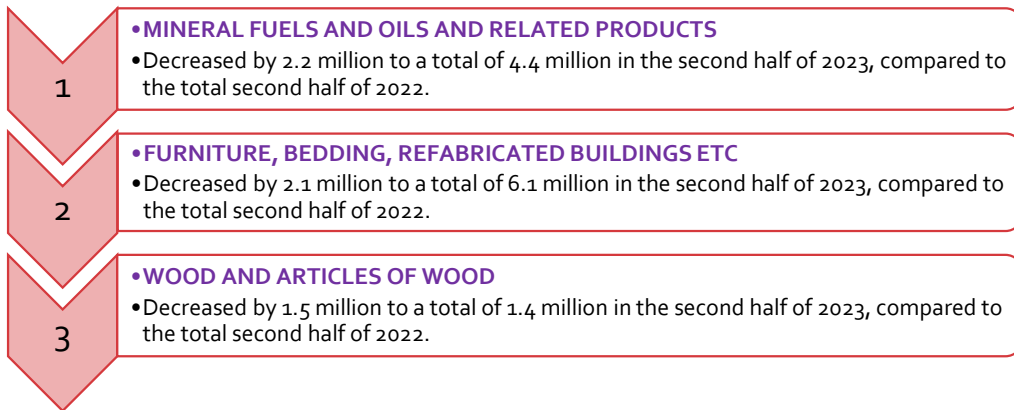
ii. Principal Imports movements for the second half of 2023

In comparing the bi-annual movements of principal commodities that were imported in the second half of 2023 with those imports in the second half of 2022.

**4. Performance of Exports:**

2022-2023: Tuvalu has exported an estimated total of \$256 thousand in 2023, of which 99.9% were of Mineral products (V).

When compared, Tuvalu has exported an estimated amount of \$75 thousand in 2022 of which 99.3% were of Mineral products (V).

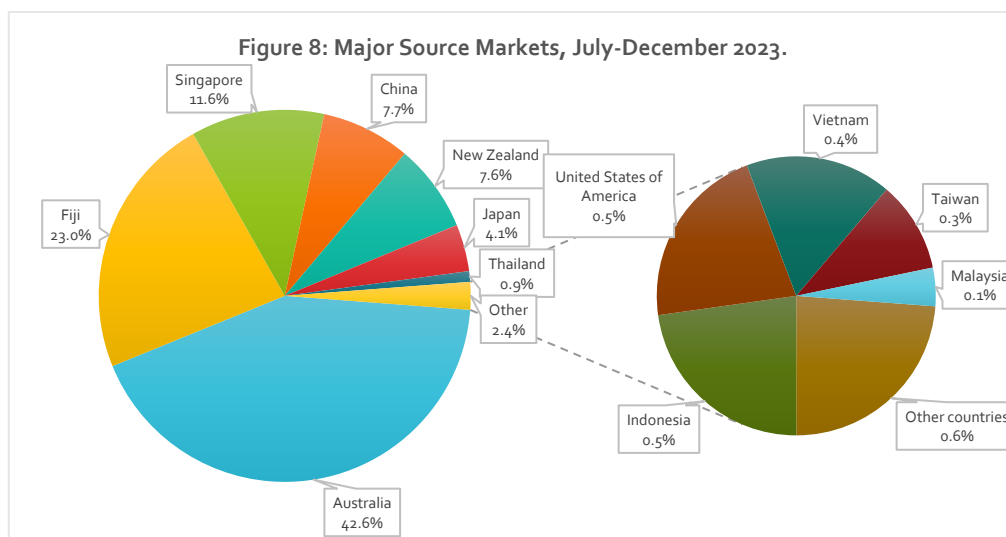

## 5. Direction of Trade:

### i. Major Source Markets:

The percentage share of all major source market of imports to Tuvalu for the second half of 2023 is illustrated in the pie graph below;



In accumulation, 73.2% totalling up to \$20.6 million of total imports were commodities imported from Tuvalu's regional countries within the Oceania (Australia, Fiji and New Zealand)

The bi-annual movements for the second half of **2023**, compared with the second half of 2022 of our top 5 major source markets (in order of total goods imported for the second half of 2023) were:

#### 1. AUSTRALIA

✚ Increased by \$1.01 million to \$11.97 million in the second half of 2023

- The largest rise was machinery & mechanical & electrical appliances & parts thereof, up \$1.87 million.
- The largest falls were chemicals and allied products, down \$0.73 million.

#### 2. FIJI

✚ Decreased by \$0.24 million to \$6.45 million in the second half of 2023

- The largest rise were prepared foodstuffs, beverages, spirits & tobacco, up \$0.53 million.
- The largest falls were machinery & mechanical & electrical appliances & parts thereof, down \$0.27 million.

#### 3. SINGAPORE

✚ Decreased by \$1.21 million to \$3.26 million in the second half of 2023

- The largest rise was wood, cork & articles thereof & plaiting material, up \$0.11 million.
- The largest falls were mineral products, down \$2.84 million.

#### 4. CHINA

✚ Decreased by \$2.45 million to \$2.18 million in the second half of 2023

- The largest rise was vegetable products, up \$0.09 million.
- The largest falls were machinery & mechanical & electrical appliances & parts thereof, down \$1.43 million.

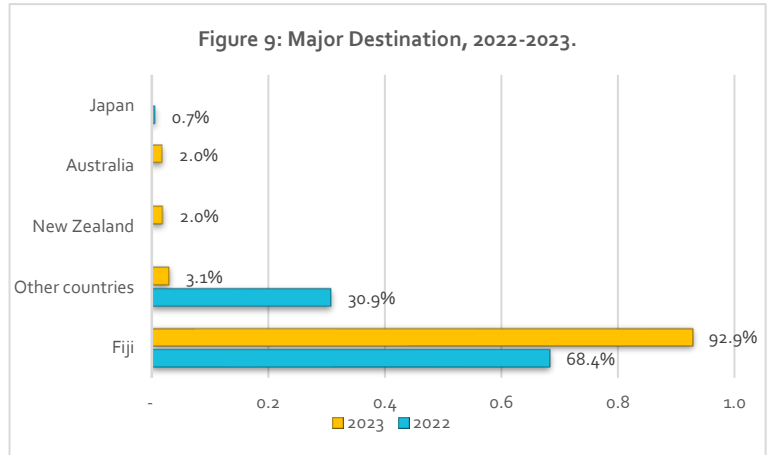
#### 5. NEW ZEALAND

✚ Decreased by \$1.2 million to \$2.14 million in the second half of 2023

- The largest rise was machinery & mechanical & electrical appliances & parts thereof, up \$0.53 million.
- The largest falls were live animals: animal products, down \$0.65 million.

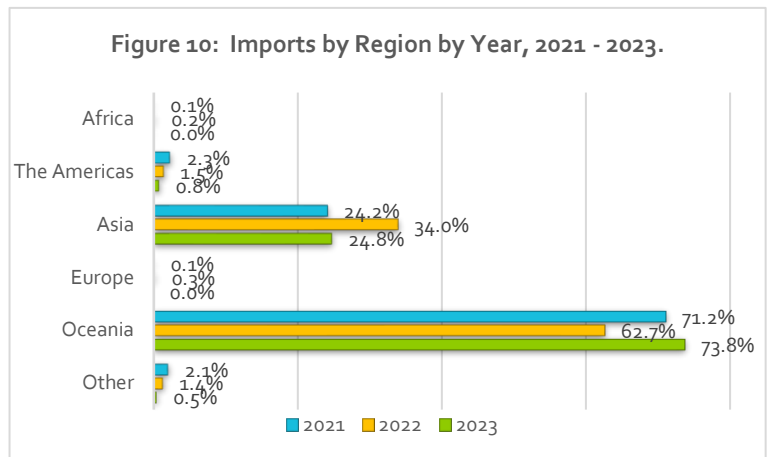
ii. Major Destinations:

**December 2023:** In reference to Figure 9, Tuvalu’s leading destination of exports for the years 2022 and 2023 was its partner country of Fiji with approximately 93% of exports in 2023, compared to 68% in 2022.



6. Trade by Geographical Region:

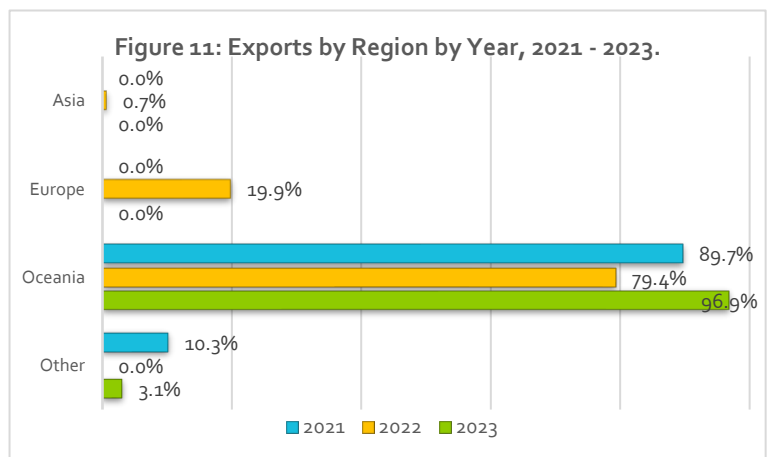
**Imports 2023:** Figure 10 alongside is an analysis of Tuvalu’s imports by geographical region from 2021 to 2023, and it shows two major regions of imports which includes Oceania and Asia.



The Oceania region dominated in imports with \$47.7 million or 74% of total imports of 2023. This was an increase of 56% of total imports from 2022, valuing around \$30.5 million.










\$16.5 million or 34% of total imports were from the Asian region in 2022, but decreased by 3% in 2023 to \$16m of total imports.

**Exports 2023:** Figure 11 illustrates the total exports by geographical region from 2021 to 2023. It shows that Tuvalu had exported mostly to countries within the Oceania region.



In 2022, Tuvalu had exported \$248 thousand or 79.4% of total exports to nearby countries within the Oceania. In 2023, exports to the Oceania region increased its shares by 18.5% to 96.9% of total exports from \$192 thousand.
