## PREFACE

This report aims to highlight statistics that are analyzed from data collected by the Tuvalu Central Statistics Division (CSD) from sources such as the Health Department, Immigration Department, outlets relevant to CPI analysis, Customs department, and more. The report outlined the statistics of certain statistical areas which include vital statistics, migration, Consumer Price Index (CPI), and trade statistics (IMTS). The vital statistics presents statistics on births and deaths, migration presents statistics of the international travels (the arrivals and departures), CPI presents the inflation rates while Trade presents statistics on Imports and Exports.

The focus of this report is to provide the statistics that should assist the audience and end-users comprehensively for their purposes. The appendix section of this report provides detailed tables from which the graphs and other tables (in chapter 1 to 4) were derived.

Furthermore, it is also important to note that certain information provided in this report may require further analysis which may result in changes to the information presented in this report. This is because data collected from sources may be incomplete and inconsistent with previously collected data and thus may have altered in accordance with statistical methods to convert them into meaningful data.

The upcoming biannual statistical bulletin should include other statistical areas that are not covered in this release. Other areas however are the GDP estimates of National Accounts, the International Investment Positions of Balance of Payments consolidations, the Foreign exchange values of Australian dollars in currencies we normally trade with, and finally, the Population estimates to be analyzed using the registered population and survey data managed by CSD.

Sincere gratitude is extended to all CSD staff for the effort in data collections, entering data, analyzing data, and producing statistical information. Lots of appreciation and thanks are dedicated to usual data sources as well for their willingness to continuously share data for analysis.

## 1. Vital Statistics

### 1.1 Overview

The statistics presented in this section were analyzed base on data collected from the Health department only. And therefore, registration data of the registry managed by the Attorney General office is not part of the analyses provided in this section.

The usual demographic indicators of vital statistics such as rates of birth, death, mortality, and others were not analyzed in this report and yet to produce. This is due to population estimates of years after 2017 censuses are yet to be analyzed. The upcoming CRVS statistical compilation following that of 2012 to 2016 one, will be covering analyses that will provide additional vital statistics demographic indicators of the population.

The department is responsible for producing a CRVS report following that of the 2012 to 2016 report. It will produce relevant assessment base statistical information for vital statistics.

### 1.2 Births 2018-2020

### 1.2.1 Births by month

Figure 1: Total Births by Month 2018-2020


The graph shows the trend of births per month for 2018 to 2020. Births appear to peak during the months of March, April, and May for all years respectively and tend to decrease later in the year.
1.2.2 Total births by Island of birth 2018-2020


Figure 2 provides an overview of the total number of births by the island of occurrence. The chart clearly illustrates that approximately $95 \%$ to $96 \%$ of births occurred in Funafuti where the remaining $4 \%$ to $5 \%$ of births occurred in the outer islands for the years 2018 to 2020. It can be observed as well that certain islands in Tuvalu do not have births outlined in the chart and this signifies that either no births occurred on the island or were not reported. The analyses however reveal that most births occur in Funafuti where the main hospital, Princess Margaret Hospital is located.

### 1.2.3 Total births by age of mothers 2018-2020

Figure 3 represents the total number of births distributed by age groups of mothers for the years 2018 to 2020. The age group 25-29 years of age had the highest frequency of births for 2018 and the age group 20-24 years of age had the highest frequency of births for years 2019 and 2020. As expected births tend to decrease as the age of mothers increase.


Note: The 2020 recorded cases were those that occurred from January to June

### 1.3 Deaths 2018-2020

### 1.3.1 Total Deaths

It is somewhat difficult to determine a trend when assessing the graph at first glance. However, the linear regression lines show that deaths tend to increase as the year progresses. Deaths peaked during March for the year 2018, May for the year 2019 and January for the year 2020.

### 1.3.2 Deaths by age group 2018-2020

It is as expected that most deaths occur at the later stage of life. When people get older, health complications tend to increase. Deaths peaked at age groups 80+ and 70-74 for the year 2018 ( 13 deaths), the age group 60-64 for the year 2019 ( 20 deaths) and the age group 65-69 for the year 2020 ( 22 deaths).

### 1.3.3 Causes of Death 2018-2019

[^0]Figure 6 shows the number of deaths classified by the causes for the years 2018 and 2019. A significant number of cases recorded "NIL" as a cause of death which are categorized as "not specified" (NS) in Figure 6. This reflects data collected from the Health Department and is mostly a result of incomplete reporting from outer islands. This is a major concern for the Public Health Department and measures are currently being undertaken to mitigate this issue. Causes of death with low occurrences were aggregated under the "other" category which includes electrocution, ketoacidosis, pancreatitis, and others.

Furthermore, the classification of causes of death in the graph above is not classified according to the International Classification of Diseases (ICD). Discussions with the Public Health Department suggest that there will be attempts to use ICD standards soon. Having causes of death classified to a certain standard is important in determining statistics related to Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs), tuberculosis and other diseases or infections worth noting. Also, the classification of causes of death for the year 2020 was not available and therefore it is not reflected in Figure 6 on the previous page.

## 2. Migration

### 2.1 Overview

The statistics pertaining to the international movement of the population are important as they are contributing information towards population estimates and projections. The analyses provide in this section focuses on the international arrivals, and in particular for visitors, together with the departures of mainly the residents.

In response to COVID-19, the Tuvalu Government decided to enforce a State of Emergency in Tuvalu resulting in the closing of borders for travel to and from Tuvalu. This measure ultimately led to a tremendous decrease in international travels with resulted in zero incidences from April to June of the year 2020.

### 2.2 Arrivals 2018 - 2020

### 2.2.1 Total Arrivals

Figure 7 is a graphical representation of the total number of arrivals for the years 2018 and 2020. It can be interpreted from the graph that the highest occurrence of arrival was during December for the year 2018 and during August for the year 2019. Trend line show a dramatic decrease in arrivals for the year 2020.


### 2.2.2 Visitor arrivals and purpose of visit

The graphs in Figure 8 below show the number of visitors according to the purpose of visit. A large portion of visitors stated their purpose of visit as Holiday for the year 2018 and as Business/Commerce for the year 2019. As mentioned in previous sections of this report, travel restrictions for the year 2020 caused a tremendous decrease in the number of people visiting Tuvalu and this is also evident in figure 8 below.

### 2.2.3 Arrivals by Nationality 2018

The majority of visitors appear to be from Fiji, New Zealand and Australia. Visitors from countries such as Algeria, Turkey and other countries with a low occurrence of visitors to Tuvalu were aggregated under the category "OTHER".

### 2.3 Departure 2018-2020

### 2.3.1 Total Departures

Figure 10 below illustrate the total departures by month. Departures for 2019 are comparatively higher than 2018 departures especially when focusing on August and it is expected to be as such due to the Pacific Islands Forum that was held in Tuvalu during August 2019.

2.3.2 Purpose of departure

Figure 11: Column graph showing the distribution of departures by purpose of travel It is evident from the chart that the majority of departures are those traveling and stating their purpose of travel as "Family/Social". Second to that would be those stating their purpose of departure as "Government" which means those traveling overseas on official / Government duty.

## 3. Consumer Price Index (CPI)

The Tuvalu Consumer Price Index expression is based on December (4th Quarter) 2019. In the meantime, the prices are collected on the main island only, Funafuti. The department however is planning to extend collections to include the outer islands.

There is a separate publication on the Consumer Price Index that will be published by the Central Statistics Division and will provide a more comprehensive description of a price increase and major changes that contribute to the increase. Therefore, this section will only provide graphical representations of the data that is provided in the CPI Release.

## 4. International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS)

This section of this report provides a summary of International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS) which is an area of statistics that analyses imports and exports. There will be a separate, more detailed publication of IMTS (IMTS Release 01/2021) by the Tuvalu Central Statistics Division. Therefore, this report only provides summaries on key indicators produced in the IMTS Releases.

### 4.1 Import \& Exports



Figure 14: Bar graph detailing imports \& exports for the years 2018 to 2020
As demonstrated in the graph, exports are exponentially far lower when compared to imports. The highest import for the year 2018 was AUD 4,594,546 whereas the highest total export for the same year was AUD 49,294. Similarly, the total import for 2019 was AUD 6,738,465 with a total export of AUD 61,593. Exports during the year 2020 are significantly less than exports for 2018 and 2019. This was a result of border closure due to COVID-19 restrictions in Tuvalu which lead to a decrease in the re-export of fuel.

Import and export items are classified using the Harmonized Coding System of Tuvalu and similar items/products are further grouped into sections. Imports on items from SECTION V - Mineral Products, was the highest compared to other sections which amounted to AUD 8,157,603 for the year 2019. This is a similar case for the year 2018 where SECTION V amounted to AUD 7,339,132. In terms of export, SECTION V - Mineral Products amounted to AUD 177,743 the highest export for 2018, and a total of AUD 335,620 for the year 2019 which was also its highest export section. Re-exports for 2018 to 2020 mainly consist of items from SECTION V, fuel for Fiji Airways airplanes. A total of AUD 176,347 was recorded as re-exported fuel under SECTION $V$ for the year 2018, a total of $\$ 335,475$ was recorded for 2019, and a total of $\$ 47,981$ for 2020.
